# Images of Research 2018-19: Rules

Capture your research creatively!

<b>Your research</b>	Your image needs, in some way, to connect, comment on or represent your research. You can be as creative as you like to capture the viewer's imagination.
<b>Unique</b>	Your image should be a photo or a drawing/painting which you have created yourself, not downloaded from Wikimedia or other image bank!
<b>Format</b>	Your image can be in full colour, sepia or black and white, landscape or portrait.
<b>Resolution</b>	Your image <b>must</b> be of a high resolution (at least 2-3 megabytes) and in either a <i>jpg</i> or <i>tif</i> format so that it prints successfully at A4 (no <i>gif</i> files please) . <b>Note: you do not need to print it.</b>
<b>Title and Description</b>	Along with your image please write a snappy title and a concise description of your image and how it relates to your research. Less than 150 words please and in plain English (no jargon!).
<b>Deadline</b>	Please email your image and your description to <a href="mailto:ian.livingstone@northampton.ac.uk">ian.livingstone@northampton.ac.uk</a> by <b>December 14th 2018</b> . Make sure you email the FULL SIZE image for best quality.
<b>Copyright</b>	By entering the competition you are giving the Graduate School permission to use your entry for exhibition and publications, in the context of Images of Research.
